Toronto, ON: Students for the Exploration and Development of Space (SEDS-Canada) has selected two finalist teams for the 2020-21 <u>Canadian Stratospheric Balloon Experiment (CAN-SBX)</u> Design Challenge. CAN-SBX is a competition for Canadian post-secondary students to design and test a scientific payload to fly on-board a stratospheric balloon provided by the <u>Canadian Space Agency</u> (CSA).

The 2020-21 CAN-SBX Design Challenge is an extension of the 2019-20 launch campaign that was delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Student payloads will be flying on board a brand new CSA expandable balloon platform that will reach up to 30 km into the stratosphere!

The CAN-SBX 2021 selected teams are:

- The **PolyOrbite** team from **Polytechnique Montréal** will be testing a novel optical multi-gas sensor ("optical nose") for atmospheric gas sensing, as well as validating the operations of a plant incubator intended to fly on-board a 3U cubesat. *Point of Contact: loana Bruj*
- The Queen's Space Engineering Team HORIZON project from Queen's University is demonstrating a low-cost and lightweight attitude determination system using commercial off-the-shelf cameras to image Earth's horizon during flight. Point of Contact: <u>Kate Szabo</u>

These teams will be joining the Western UBT and McMaster NEUDOSE teams selected in 2019. The goal of CAN-SBX 2019-21 is for students to gain enough experience to lead balloon launches from their home institutions. Teams will be able to attend the launch campaign and participate in the launch, operations, and recovery of their experiments!
